

Postpartum Services Offered for Infants with Special Healthcare Needs.



1. **Postpartum doula:** support for families of infants with special healthcare needs. This service I am wearing my Doula hat with the knowledge of an occupational therapist. I provide the traditional doula support and am able to answer and guide your questions and concerns from my knowledge as an occupational therapist.

Investment

- Basic package \$995 which includes 5, 3-hour home visits.
- OHP flex funds may cover the entire expense if your flex fund application is approved.

2. **Home services for hospitalized infants:** I offer home services wearing my occupational therapy hat with the knowledge of a postpartum doula. These unique services will include education and practical strategies on how to care for your baby with special healthcare needs. If therapy is needed, your baby will receive services in conjunction with the program. This portion will be more hands on with your baby for part of the visit. In conjunction with offering the skills and knowledge to confidently care for your new baby, I will help to protect and provide the nurturing 4th trimester you and your baby deserve. This may include light housekeeping and meal prep, sibling adjustment, infant sleep and feeding etc. I will also help set up supports and connect with community resources you could benefit from.

Investment

- Basic package: \$650 which includes: 4 home visits, 3 hours a visit, catered to your specific needs.
- Insurance may supplement the cost based on an individual basis.
- OHP flex funds may cover the entire expense if your flex fund application is approved.

- Body and bottle feeding

- Sibling adjustment
- Newborn sleep education
- Attachment Education
- Soothing Techniques
- Developmental support through activities and education
- Sensory Parenting: how to read the cues of your baby with regards to their sensory preferences such as: sensory bathing, different positions for holding and sleeping, light and noise preferences, cues of overstimulation, how to maintain happy, healthy sensory processing (look at the sensory parenting books.
- Environmental modification to help ease the transition from the womb.
